Historic hotspots

- 1 SPRING HILL**
Outside the Ventnor Heritage Museum
Find out about the Island's royal prisoner... and beer.
- 2 WINTER GARDENS**
Pier Street, at the top of the Cascade
Dance back in time to the 1930s.
- 3 VENTNOR HAVEN**
In front of the water pumping station
The lost pier and the town's goddess of health.
- 4 ESPLANADE**
On the railings to the East of the Spyglass Inn
From smugglers to bracing sea water baths.
- 5 CHURCH STREET**
On Kingsview, opposite St Catherine's Church
The art deco cinema and our famous microclimate.
- 6 STEEPHILL**
By the bus stop on Park Avenue, near Ventnor Park
The forgotten castle and award-winning park.
- 7 BOTANIC GARDEN**
By the wall at the garden entrance
The site of a vast hospital for TB, the Victorian killer.
- 8 INDUSTRIAL ESTATE**
Ocean View Road opposite the Industrial Estate
Travel back in time to the golden age of steam.
- 9 VENTNOR DOWNS**
Opposite the former radar station
A secret bunker, magic well and ancient cemetery.
